

## Activity Ideas for Sunday 29<sup>th</sup> March

### Bible Story: Matthew 19:13-26



Hopefully you heard Esther tell this Bible story in the service. You can read it yourself in your Bible.

I wonder what you learnt from the Bible story? Could you imagine yourself there, meeting Jesus and hearing him talk to the crowds?

**How do you want to respond to the story? Here are a few ideas of things you could do whilst the sermon is happening:**

1. Imagine you were one of the children who met Jesus. What would you tell him about what you've been doing last week? Write a letter to Jesus telling him about the good and bad things which have happened to you lately.

2. God has made an amazing variety of creatures in our world. What do you know about camels. Could you look up some facts?

3. Try drawing a camel. Or perhaps you could even try this messy hand painting idea!

4. Make a Lego scene of Jesus meeting the children or perhaps the rich young ruler.

5. Colour in the picture of the camel and the needle (see separate pdf)

6. If you could sing or dance for Jesus, what would you sing? You might like to make up a song or a dance.



7. Write or say a prayer thanking God for the good things in your week and asking for his help with things that worry you.
